Faith That Can Digest Painful Things

In these trying times, the faith of Unificationists is being challenged as seldom before. What is our responsibility before God? We are tempted to avert our gaze, and say, “none of this is my concern...” The following paragraphs discuss painful topics, so if your faith does not include painful things, you may want to bail out now...

I imagine there are many sisters who have dreamed about what it would be like to be married to the Messiah, but after watching True Father for four decades I can imagine how excruciatingly difficult that would be. We all have to be grateful that Hak Ja Han put herself in that position, and repent deeply to God and True Father, if, for any reason, she left it at the last moment.

In his 9/20/15 sermon, “The Burning of Babylon,” Hyung Jin Nim shared about an email he recently received from a Korean member who attended Father's Hoon Dok Hwe on Jan. 19, 2012. In this email he explained that the Peace TV and History Compilation Committee chose not to record Father's strong words. Fortunately, this member took notes of Father's HDK that morning, which follows.

2012-1-19 Hoon Dok Hwe Notes

As usual this day also after the HDH reading, True Father spoke. But what was unusual was that his talk was about True Mother. His words were frank and painful, filled with fire and regrets. Those present were embarrassed. Here were some of his points:

- * "True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind" is not two as Father and Mother, but one.*
- * Mother is Father's platform. Just eating with and following Father around does not automatically make her True Mother.*
- * Acting separately will cause doom and death.*
- * Those who do not respond to Father and just hang around Mother are villains.*
- * Do not brag about Anju (Mother's hometown) and the family name Han. If you do that you don't become True Mother.*
- * Mother is going her own way like a Dokkaebi (demon). She is not walking the same road as Father.*
- * You villains (True Children, executive aides and church leaders [mentioned by name]) are following Mother and walking a different path than me. Villains!*
- * Anyone who follows Mother and thinks he doesn't need Father is a rootless Dokkaebi.*
- * Only Heavenly Father is with lonely Father.*
- * For Mother to say "Don't listen to Father, listen to me" is a more frightening than Lucifer.*

** I am all alone now. I don't have any sons or daughters. Mother plays her own game.
* When Hyo Jin was alive he said to me -"Father, I feel sorry for you. Why is Mother not listening you, and doing her own thing?"*

True Father proclaimed: From this time on Mother has to absolutely obey Father. Then Father asked Mother who was sitting next to him to stand up and go to in front of the table face Father. Then True Father called Drs. Jun-Ho Seok, Sun-Jo Hwang, Jeong-Lo Yoon, and Hyo-Yul Kim (Peter Kim) to the front to make a line behind True Mother and made all raise hands including all Hoon Dok Hae participants to pledge absolute obedience. True Father repeatedly urged True Mother to answer "Oj(Yes)". He then asked everyone to raise their hands and clap to confirm they knew Father's will and seal this special ceremony.

PS: Because cameras and tape recorders were not allowed, I had to check with several who attended and have faithfully recorded what transpired as best I could until the Weekly Planning and History Compilation Committee can provide a detailed record.

Hyung Jin Nim explained that those at the palace who spoke about uplifting Father as the Messiah were bullied by “thought police” who told them they shouldn't be talking about Father anymore. This was the time only to honor the reign of “victorious True Mother.” Such “thought police” were following the precedent of Mother herself.

Erasure of Father's strong and controversial words because “it would damage our image” is shameful, Hyung Jin Nim said, explaining, “We don't care about our ‘image,’ we care about the truth.”

The fate of humanity rested on Mother's choice. Like God, Father did not intervene with that, which is why Eve was represented by the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. Sadly, there are indications that, after Father’s passing, Mother chose to separate from Father.



I wrote the following letter in response to a letter that was chastising Hyung Jin Nim for speaking about Mother in a disrespectful way.

Imagine you were Hyung Jin Nim

Imagine that you were Hyung Jin Nim and that you believed what your Father/True Parents said about you in numerous public events from 2008 to 2012, that you are the heir/successor of His/True Parents' work, not in the future, *but now*.

You are working to bring health, renewal and change to the UM in Korea and Japan, with encouraging growth in membership and respect from Korean media, government institutions, but as your Father is getting ill, you see indications that your own Mother is working with church leaders to change key words and covenants that Father said not to change. You also see hundreds of millions of dollars of blood money from Japan being siphoned off by the same person who is said to be "channeling" Mother's mother as well as by other "leaders" whom Mother trusts.

You ask her on your knees many times not to make these changes. She is angry that you insist on obeying Father instead of her Cheongpyeong-centered "innovations" and has you fired from all of your responsibilities in Korea. You are sent to America where you hope that positive change can happen because of American brothers and sisters' character, history and Christian foundation. You create local and regional councils and you starting speaking and teaching to ministers and members about Father's Absolute Sex teaching.

Instructions come from your Mother through her proxies that teaching about Absolute Sex must stop immediately. Soon after you are fired from your position in America, with the demand that you come back to Korea and bow down to the same people who are desecrating your Father's words. Some of them tell you to pretend to agree with what Mother is doing and then you will take power after she goes to spirit world, but your conscience won't let you do that.



With the help of your older brother, you move your family to rural Pennsylvania and spend time communing in the outdoors all night with God and Father, holding worship services in a very bare living room, making effort to connect strongly with Jesus and Father. Brothers and sisters start to come to your worship service even though the church headquarters warns them not to go.

Your Mother continues to claim that she monopolizes Father's will and has the authority to make all kinds of changes that converge on people needing to liberate more of their ancestors by sending more of their savings to Cheongpyeong. She starts to sit on Father's throne since she IS True Parents. She starts to teach that she was born sinless (change of blood lineage in the womb), implying that she did not need to meet your Father, Sun Myung Moon, to be the "only begotten daughter of God."

You realize that, even though you have barely enough resources to take care of your family,



if you do not speak strongly to brothers and sisters around the world, that your Father's words and teaching will be erased/"polished" from the earth. You know that you will be judged as a disobedient son who was "angry," "impatient," and "power-hungry." But if you don't speak out, brothers and sisters will lose their connection to the Messiah's lineage and his foundation hijacked to support a "palace" and a place where people "pay" to have their sins removed.

But you speak out anyway, feeling God's love and protection despite the storm around you. At least you and your wife are totally united in a desire to honor Father's will. You and your family will serve and honor the Lord of the Second Advent, even if your Mother and most of those who promised not to change Father's words, threaten, mock and scorn you.
